

USR launches “PNRR Monitor” project

The Save Romania Union (USR) has launched, on Monday, the "PNRR Monitor" project, and instrument for the tracking and diagnosing of benchmarks and targets in the National Recovery and Resilience Plan (PNRR).

The online platform <https://MonitorPNRR.eu/> shows the benchmarks and targets in the PNRR, with the afferent deadlines and the analysis of their fulfillment, from the perspective of the USR.

The project is financed by the European Parliament political group Renew Europe.

"PNRR does not belong to a Government, but to European citizens, the Governments being only the institutional mechanisms to implement the programme in the interest of citizens," said, at the launching of the project, MEP Dragos Pislaru, who emphasized that these funds must be spent efficiently and transparently.

He recalled that, of the 672.5 billion euro granted at the European level, through the PNRR, Romania is allotted over 29 billion euro.

The former Minister of European Investments and Projects, Cristian Ghinea, explained that the monitor has a search engine usable to search by words, pillars, components, as well as a timer to the finalization of the PNRR and the allotments by components - transport, healthcare, education, etc.

The "PNRR Monitor" team also launched on Monday the "PNRR Health Bulletin," an analysis report which will have a quarterly frequency and will include alerts regarding the situation of the plan and will offer a look on the manner of implementation.
